

SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR OUTDOOR WORSHIP SERVICES

GENERAL

- Masks are required at site
- Maintain physical distance (6 ft) from others
- Remain home if you are not feeling well
- Greeters will meet you and direct you through the process

ARRIVAL

1. Park near the outdoor event site in designated parking areas.
2. No-touch thermometers will be used to check temperatures as people arrive. If a person registers greater than 100°F, they will be asked to return home. Masks and hand sanitizer will be available at the site and available to all.
3. Bring your own chairs (e.g., folding aluminum or camp chairs preferable) and observe distancing requirements of at least 6 feet when seated.
4. Ushers will wear masks and will help locate areas for seating.

WORSHIP

5. Order of Worship programs will be e-mailed (to be printed at home) and posted for Smartphone use to all members prior to services. Printed versions will also be available at the event site.
6. Congregational singing will NOT be done during services. Congregational prayer and responsive reading will be done in a “soft voice” while wearing masks.
7. Passing of the Peace will be a “wave of the hand” or with “smiling eyes.” Please, NO handshakes or hugs.
8. Offering plates will be available at multiple sites.

DISMISSAL

9. You may leave the area at your convenience making efforts to remain 6 ft from other individuals. Cleaning/disinfectant wipes will be available to clean your chairs or other personal objects brought to the site.

NOTES

- Restrooms will not be available.
- Children may attend worship but will remain with their family as childcare/Sunday School is not open at this time. Family members will help their children follow guidelines as outlined above.
